BADS is set up with a main objective of bringing bowling to all disabled persons in Singapore. We organise and coordinate all bowling activities which will eventually lead to the selection and training of an elite team to represent Singapore in international competitions.

We intend to maintain our reserves at a level, which is at least equivalent to **S\$100,000** (a set range, amount or manner of calculation, with justification/ reasons). This targeted minimum amount of reserves is designed to last BADS through **18 months** of operations. It is our target to achieve 1.5 Ratio of Reserves to Annual Operating Expenditure. The reserves are to be used to finance the following operations and activities:

- a) Leagues organised by BADS
- b) Learn to bowl sessions (booking of bowling lanes, logistics, coaching fees)
- c) Cost of sending BADS officials to overseas competitions not covered by SDSC.
- d) Additional training sessions (if required) that are not covered by SDSC.
- e) Annual General Meetings, Exco Meetings and gatherings.
- f) Salaries and allowances of staff

The Board regularly reviews the amount of reserves that are required to ensure that they are adequate to fulfil our continuing obligations.
