Bowling Association for the Disabled (Singapore) (BADS) is an association registered with the Registry of Societies in April 2010 and is affiliated with the Singapore Disability Sports Council (SDSC). BADS is set up with a main objective of bringing bowling to all disabled persons in Singapore. We organize and coordinate all bowling activities which will eventually lead to the selection and training of an elite team to represent Singapore in international competitions.
