We intend to maintain our reserves at a level, which is at least equivalent to **S\$100,000**. For current and previous years, our yearly expenses range from \$77,000 to \$88,000. This targeted minimum amount of reserves is designed to last BADS through **15 months** of operations if there is no income. It is our target to achieve 1.25 Ratio of Reserves to Annual Operating Expenditure. The reserves are to be used to finance the following operations and activities:

- a) Salaries and allowances of staff
- b) Learn to bowl sessions (booking of bowling lanes, logistics, coaching fees)
- c) Leagues organized by BADS
- d) Annual General Meetings, Exco Meetings and gatherings.
- c) Additional training sessions (if required) that are not covered by SDSC.
- d) Cost of sending BADS officials to overseas competitions not covered by SDSC.

The Board regularly reviews the amount of reserves that are required to ensure that they are adequate to fulfil our continuing obligations.
