**SELECTION TRIALS RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR TENPIN BOWLING**

**1. INTRODUCTION**

- 1.1 This document describes the 10<sup>th</sup> ASEAN Para Games 2020 Selection Trials rules and regulations for Tenpin Bowling.
- 1.2 The Selection Trials will serve as the selected qualifying event for Tenpin Bowling in the 10<sup>th</sup> ASEAN Para Games 2020.
- 1.3 The administration of this Selection Trials will be conducted by Bowling Association for the Disabled (Singapore), which is the National Disability Sports Association for Tenpin Bowling.
- 1.4 Bowlers must participate in ALL 4 sessions of the Selection Trials. Bowlers that participate less than 3 sessions, their scores will not be considered.
- 1.5 Bowlers will be required to bowl 6 games in each session.
- 1.6 Bowlers will be evaluated based on the best scores of 3-sessions.
- 1.7 A registration is MANDATORY for the Selection Trials (refer to 7 for contact details).
- 1.8 Registration closing date: Friday 19 April 2019, 6pm. No registration will be accepted after the closing date. Bowlers who are not registered or have not paid the full fees will not be permitted to participate in the Selection Trials.

**2. DATES, TIME AND VENUE**

- 2.1 The dates for the Selection Trials are:  
Session 1: Sunday 5 May 2019  
Session 2: Sunday 12 May 2019  
Session 3: Sunday 19 May 2019  
Session 4: Sunday 26 May 2019

2.2 The Selection Trials will be held at **Temasek Club (131 Rifle Range Road, Singapore 588406), 11am**. Registration will start at 10.30am.

2.3 There will be NO make-up sessions for the Selection Trials.

### **3. FEES**

3.1 The Selection Trial fees (for all 4 sessions) are:

### **4. ELIGIBILITY FOR SELECTION TRIALS**

4.1 To be eligible for Selection Trials, the bowlers must:

i) Be a Singapore citizen

ii) Be over 15 years old in 2019 (Calculation: 2019 minus year born)

iii) Comply with the sport-specific classification rules

iv) Be in good standing with SNPC, SDSC and BADS

v) Be members of para tenpin bowling association(s)

### **5. MINIMUM QUALIFYING STANDARDS (MQS)**

5.1 The minimum qualifying standards (MQS) can be found in Annex A. The MQS is guided by SNPC's selection criteria, which is the third (3<sup>rd</sup>) placing performance of the 2017 ASEAN Para Games (for quantifiable sports) and third ranking among ASEAN countries (for non-quantifiable sports).

## **Annex B – Selection Trials General Playing Rules**

### **B1. BOWLING RULES AND REGULATIONS**

B1.1 All World Para Bowling (WPB) bowling rules and regulations will apply to this Selection Trial.

### **B2. CLASSIFICATION CRITERIA**

B2.1 Bowlers must fall under the classification criteria by the World Para Bowling (WPB), International Blind Sports Federation (IBSA) and International Sports Federation for Persons with Intellectual Disability (INAS).

### **B3. ATTIRE**

B3.1 Bowlers must wear appropriate bowling attire. Proper attire will be strictly enforced, as this is a National Level Selection Trial for a major tournament.

B3.2 Bowlers are to wear their respective association's collared t-shirts with long pants. The wearing of jeans, shorts, tank tops, hats, torn clothing or shirts with offensive wording or inappropriate images that may offend others will not be accepted.

B3.3 Bowling shoes for all bowlers.

B3.4 No form of any headwear except scarf for Malay Muslim female bowlers.

### **B4. EQUIPMENT**

B4.1 All bowlers are responsible for the care, transportation and storage of all their personal equipment/belongings. The Bowling Association for the Disabled (Singapore), Singapore Disability Sports Council, and Temasek Club will not be responsible and liable for any lost or damaged equipment/belongings.

B4.2 All TPB1 bowlers are responsible for providing their own guiderails.

B4.3 All TB1 bowlers must bring and wear their own blindfold or blind sports goggles/eyeshades.

B4.4 Only two bowling balls are allowed at any time on the ball dispenser for each bowler.

B4.5 Altering the bowling ball surface during a game is not allowed. Altering the bowling ball surface is only permitted before the start of a new game.

### **B5. PINS-SPOTTER**

B5.1 All TPB1 bowlers need to arrange for their own respective pins-spotter.

B5.2 All TPB1 bowlers must register their pins-spotter for the Selection Trials.

- B5.3 Pins-spotters shall assist bowlers only at the bowlers' area in the following matters:
- i) Locating the bowlers' ball on the ball return.
  - ii) Informing the bowler directions of the ball after delivery, pins left standing, and scores.
  - iii) Pin spotters are not allowed to verbally or physically assist bowlers during a deliver

## **B6. WHEELCHAIR**

- B6.1 No electrical/motorized wheelchairs are allow for TPB8 bowlers.
- B6.2 All TPB8 bowlers are responsible for providing their own non-electrical/non-motorized wheelchairs.

## **B7. FORMAT OF PLAY**

- B7.1 Bowlers will bowl 6 games in each session (total 4 sessions).
- B7.2 There will be a lane change to the next pair of lanes to the right after 3 games. Lane change will rotate within the assigned lanes of the respective categories.
- B7.3 Bowlers are responsible to transfer their equipment to the next pair if lanes and can only start doing so upon instructions given by the Selection Trials Officials.

## **B8. TARDY (LATE) BOWLERS**

- B8.1 In the event of tardy (late) bowlers, the bowler may be permitted to join in at the frame of the game that the opponent bowler is bowling, in the respective lane. The clock in the host venue shall be the official timepiece.

## **B10. PLAYER'S AREA**

- B9.1 ONLY Selection Trials Officials, National Coaches, National Team Manager, and registered Pins-Spotter are allowed to be in the player's area. Unauthorized personnel are to stay behind the player's area.
- B9.2 Eating and drinking in the player's area are strictly not permitted.

## **B10. NON-NATIONAL COACHES**

- B10.1 Non-national coaches are NOT permitted to coach at all times.
- B10.2 Non-national coaches are not allowed to move into the player's area or hold up play.
- B10.3 Non-national coaches may stand directly behind the player's area for bowlers but are NOT ALLOWED to communicate with the bowlers. The bowler will be disqualified if this happens.
- B10.4 Only the appointed National Coaches are allowed to assist the bowlers.

## **B11. CONDUCT**

B11.1 Bowlers must conduct themselves in a sportsperson like manner while competing or while in the Selection Trials' venue. Un-sportsperson like conduct will not be tolerated and will lead to the bowler's disqualification

## **B12. SMOKING**

B12.1 Smoking is prohibited from the commencement of warm-up through to the completion of the day's play of the Selection Trials.

B12.2 If a bowler is caught smoking during a game, the score for the game will be zero pin fall.

B12.3 If a bowler is caught smoking during an interval of a game, the subsequent score for the game will be zero pin fall.

## **B13. DISPUTES**

B13.1 Any protests, disputes or complaints arising during the Selection Trials must be lodged with the Selection Trials Officials immediately of the alleged infringement, and confirmed in writing within 24 hours.

B13.2 Disputes will be adjudicated by the Selection Trials Officials, and at least one SDSC Official. Their decision will be final.

## **B14. SCORING ERROR**

B14.1 In the event of any scoring error, the bowler must inform the Selection Trials Officers immediately.

B14.2 Correction to the scoring can only be adjusted by Selection Trials Officials and Temasek Club counter staff.

B14.3 Any unauthorized changing of the scores will result in immediate disqualification.
